Oct. 25 Invitation to Wayside Cross Ministries' Groundbreaking Ceremony for Its New Facility



Aurora, Ill., Oct. 17, 2013 (The Religion Wire™) — In the planning stages for over four years, Aurora-based **Wayside Cross Ministries (WCM)** has issued a public invitation for a **groundbreaking ceremony** on **Friday Oct. 25, 10 a.m.**, for their construction of a new 47,000 sq. ft., four-story facility at their current location of 215 E. New York St.

Aurora Mayor Tom Weisner and other local, state, and federal dignitaries will participate in the ceremony and be joined by project supporters including U.S. Bank, Consortium America, and HomeTown National Bank. Two of their 100-year-old buildings will be demolished to accommodate the new structure.

The new building will contain classrooms and counseling offices, kitchen facilities and dining hall. The living quarters will be designed to serve individuals enrolled in seven to 18 month programs.

The men's ministry and general offices will be housed in the new facility. The offices include the WCM Executive Director's office, the business office, development offices, and the ministry offices for Master's Touch Ministry, Urban Youth Ministry, and New Life Corrections Ministry.
